Sir/Madam,

Keeping in view the power surrendered by Odisha and Delhi and the willingness of Government of Gujarat to take this Power, it has been decided to re-allocate 716.33 MW Power to Gujarat from the Power Stations of NTPC given below along with the quantum as indicated in the table below:

Sr. No.	Power Station	Off take power in MW	Surrendered by	Period	Remarks
1.	Barh-I	139.33	Odisha	from 01.07.2022 to 31.03.2027	This Power was earlier allocated to Gujarat vide allocation order no. 22-302/1/2021-OM dated 12.03.2022 upto June, 2022.
2.	Dadri-I	577	Delhi	From 01.04.2023 to 31.03.2027	This Power was earlier allocated to Gujarat vide allocation order no. 22-302/1/2021-OM dated 25.03.2022 upto March, 2023.

2. In case some unit(s) in the above mentioned plant(s) is/are under shutdown at present, the share equivalent to that unit shall not be considered as reallocated to Gujarat as the State needs power to meet its urgent requirement.

3. The beneficiary is required to sign/extent PPA and enters into commercial arrangements/maintain LC with the allocated power.

3. CEA is requested to get the allocation implemented under intimation to all concerned with **immediate effect based on the availability of ATC.**
